
Regarding the allegation that a former client will not pay monies owed to you pursuant to a court decision, you must pursue your civil remedies. Our Committee has no jurisdiction over that matter. Your allegations regarding the manner in which you were substituted in a case involving that client was encompassed in the decision mandating you to turn over your files. Our Committee has no authority to overrule or further expound on a court decision.

Regarding your allegations that an Order to Show Cause was improperly instituted and decided against you; you may take this issue to an appellate court for review. Our Committee has no jurisdiction or authority to review such matters.

Finally you are advised that any complaint you have against a judge must be filed with the Commission on Judicial Conduct.

Accordingly, we are unable to assist you in this matter.
