COMMITTEE ON BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS

CITIZENS' BUDGET ADVISORY COMMITTEE

A. Committee Established

There is hereby created a Citizens' Budget Advisory Committee to consist of not less than nine (9) nor more than twelve (12) members, to be selected by the Committee on Budget and Appropriations; representing the diversity of County residents and interests. The Chairperson of the Committee shall be chosen by the Committee members themselves. It is urged that the designees have an accounting, budgetary or financial background. Said designees shall be made as soon as practicable.

B. Compensation

The members of such Committee shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be entitled to reimbursement for their reasonable and actual expenses to be approved by the Clerk of the Board in conjunction with the Chair(s) of the Committee on Budget and Appropriations.

C. Terms

All members shall serve for a two year period commencing with January 1, 2002 through December 31, 2003.

D. Duties

1. The Committee shall review the proposed Capital and Operating Budgets by the County Executive and make written recommendations thereon no later than five (5) days prior to the date specified for the deadline for additions to the Budget (the first Monday in December) to the Committee on Budget and Appropriations.

2. Recommendations shall include a review of the proposed tax rate and a recommendation as to the level of proposed expenditures necessary to provide for an appropriate level of County government and its programs and services. The Committee can include in its recommendations such other matters of concern that the Committee deems warranted.

On December 12, 1994, prior to adopting the 1995 Proposed County Budget as amended, this Board of Legislators unanimously voted to support "...the creation of a Citizen's Budget Advisory Committee (CBAC), comprised of individuals from varied backgrounds and experience, who will meet regularly throughout the year to review all matters related to the County Budget and budget process. We look forward to reviewing the issue on our Committee's agenda beginning in January."

In January George Latimer and I began drafting the details of a Citizen's Budget Advisory Committee. The Committee on Budget and Appropriations has met on and discussed the relevant details, but as yet have not agreed on how the Citizen's Budget Advisory Committee members are to be chosen.

It has been suggested that each of you look at the attached draft and advise:

1. If you believe the proposed CBAC member organizations are representative of the "varied background and experience" the Board of Legislators intended,
2. or, if you would prefer a CBAC whose members (one per member) are appointed by the Budget Committee,
3. -or, if there's a third alternative.

The Budget Committee will be finalizing this proposal at its meeting on Monday, April 3rd at 3:00 p.m. I would appreciate having any comments and/or recommendations you may have on this proposal before or at that time.

CITIZENS' BUDGET ADVISORY COMMITTEE

A. Committee Established

There is hereby created a Citizens' Budget Advisory Committee to consist of a total of eight (8) members, one (1) from each of the following organizations: Westchester County Association, Westchester County League of Women Voters, Westchester County Taxpayers Alliance, Westchester County Chapter of the AICPA, a faculty member designated by the Pace University School of Government, the Westchester County Chamber of Commerce, the Westchester Municipal Officials Association and a representative of City government, rotated annually between the Cities of Yonkers, Mount Vernon, New Rochelle and White Plains, selected by the respective City's Mayor. The Chairperson of the Committee shall be chosen by the Committee members themselves. It is urged that the aforementioned organizations designate a member with an accounting, budgetary or financial background. Said designees shall be made by said organizations by June 1st of each year.

B. Compensation

The members of such Committee shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be entitled to reimbursement for their reasonable and actual expenses.

C. Terms

All members shall serve for a one-year period commencing with July 1, 1995 through June 30, 1996.

D. Duties

1. The Committee shall review the proposed Capital and Operating Budgets by the County Executive and make written recommendations thereon by NOV. 27th 1995, to the Committee on Budget and Appropriations.

2. Recommendations shall include a review of the proposed tax rate and a recommendation as to the level of proposed expenditures necessary to provide for an appropriate level of County government and its programs and services. The Committee can include in its recommendations such other matters of concern that the Committee deems warranted.
