**Subject:** GOOD NEWS! -- You can EASILY defeat Assemblyman Goodell -- & demonstrate your fitness for public service

### TO: 150<sup>th</sup> Assembly District Candidate Christina Cardinale (D)

I can help you win! **If you make the complaint your campaign issue, you will win – EASILY and without money. As a candidate, you have a "bully pulpit". Stand up for honest and accountable government: publicly call on Assemblyman Goodell to respond to the complaint – which I furnished him -- publicly call upon District Attorney Swanson to explain why he has not presented the complaint to a Chautauqua County grand jury, and publicly call upon the press to do its part and investigate and report. Also announce, publicly, that, if elected, you will not take the \$30,500 pay-raise procured through the December 10, 2018 report of the Committee on Legislative and Executive Compensation, because the report is a "false instrument", violative of penal laws – and publicly commit that you will ensure: (1) public findings of fact and conclusions of law with respect to the complaint; (2) prosecution of all culpable public officers and their conspirators; and (3) "claw-backs" to recover the approximately half a billion dollars in fraudulent salary increases, already paid out.**
