**This is to alert you to the GOOD NEWS.** You can win election easily and without money against Rockland County's re-election-seeking state legislative incumbents. All it requires is using the "bully-pulpit" of your candidacy to whistle-blow about the above-attached FULLY-DOCUMENTED public corruption/grand jury complaint against them, which Rockland County District Attorney Walsh has been "sitting on". The complaint establishes, with EVIDENCE, that they must be indicted on EVIDENCE so *prima facie* and open-and-shut as to assure convictions.

Rockland County's press has known about the complaint for some time – and illustrative is the below September 18<sup>th</sup> e-mail to some of its "local journalism", to which Rockland County's six state legislative incumbents and D.A. Walsh were cc'd so that they could be ready for press inquiries. Individually and collectively, if you stand up for honest, accountable government and make the complaint your campaign issue, you will win – easily. Demand that the complained-against state legislators respond to the complaint, that D.A. Walsh explain why he has not presented it to a Rockland County grand jury, and that the press do its part to investigate and report.

I am available to answer your questions – and invite you to call me so that I can furnish you with specifics addressed to the incumbents against whom you are running.
