This is to alert you to GOOD NEWS. You can EASILY win election to the state legislative seats you seek – and without expenditure of money. All it requires is using the "bully-pulpit" of your candidacy to whistle-blow about the above-attached FULLY-DOCUMENTED public corruption/grand jury complaint against Schenectady County's five state legislators – four seeking re-election – which Schenectady County District Attorney Carney has been "sitting on". The complaint establishes, with EVIDENCE, that the incumbent state legislators must be indicted on EVIDENCE so *prima facie* and open-and-shut as to assure convictions.

The Daily Gazette and other Schenectady County "local journalism" have known about the complaint for some time. Subject: Schenectady County Elections 2020 -- Informing Voters with EVIDENCE: public corruption/grand jury complaint vs Schenectady County's 5 state legislators -- 4 running for re-election -- which Schenectady County D.A. Carney is "sitting on"

## TO: The Daily Gazette

Schenectady County's five state legislators – 4 running for re-election – are the subjects of a **fully-documented** public corruption/grand jury complaint, filed with Schenectady County District Attorney Carney, who has been "sitting on" it. The complaint involves the "force of law" commission/committee scheme that gave <u>all three of them</u> pay raises – and a legislature <u>not</u> operating at a remotely constitutional level.

The June 19, 2020 complaint, by the Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA), is above-attached – and below are the e-mails transmitting it and the above-attached July 29, 2020 FOIL request to D.A. Carney. CJA's substantiating evidentiary webpage for the complaint is here: <a href="http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/searching-nys/2020-legislative/grand-juries.htm">http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/searching-nys/2020-legislative/grand-juries.htm</a>.

As stated by the complaint, Schenectady County voters are entitled to know that their state legislators cannot be reelected because they must be indicted for larceny and other corruption on EVIDENCE so DISPOSITIVE as to assure their convictions. So, too, retiring Senator Amedore, whose salary-based pension is also larcenous.

To facilitate your inquiries of the complained-against state legislators and D.A. Carney, I am cc'ing them on this email. What, if anything, do they deny or dispute. Let them start where the complaint starts: my July 16, 2019 e-mail to the Legislature's 15 stipend-receiving leaders requesting that they forward the e-mail to the 198 other state legislators, with its attached July 15, 2019 written NOTICE and substantiating analysis establishing that the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative and Executive Compensation – raising their legislative salaries from \$79,500 to \$110,000 – is "'a fraud on the People of the State of New York – and a larceny of their tax dollars', violating a succession
