This is to alert you to GOOD NEWS. You can win, easily and without money, election for Warren County's two state legislative seats – and defeat incumbent Assemblyman Stec, running for election to the Senate. All it requires is using the “bully-pulpit” of your candidacy to whistle-blow about the above-attached FULLY-DOCUMENTED public corruption/grand jury complaint against Assemblyman Stec and retiring Senator Little, which Warren County District Attorney Carusone has been “sitting on”.
