Mamdani Can't Be Elected NYC Mayor, Because He Must Be Indicted & Will Be Convicted of Corruption, as a NYS Assemblyman

I am director and co-founder of the NY-based nonpartisan, nonprofit citizens' organization [Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. \(CJA\)](http://www.judgewatch.org) – and, in that capacity, interacted with Zohran Mamdani, by four e-mails, in 2020, when he was running to be elected as a NYS assemblyman from Queens, and again, this year, by four e-mails in March.

Most important of these is my [March 14th e-mail to Mamdani](#) entitled “ELECTIONS ARE A TIME OF ACCOUNTABILITY...”, as it summarizes the four e-mails in 2020, which it also furnishes – and then recites and furnishes the EVIDENCE of his corruption, upon his taking office in January 2021, pertaining to the state budget, his own legislative salary, and NY's oversight/“public protection” entities, destroying constitutional, lawful state governance and causing vast, irreparable injury to the People of New York.

I sent Mamdani the March 14th e-mail a second time, with a supplement, by a [March 17th e-mail](#), and sent both to him again when I cc'd him on my [March 18th](#) and [March 20th](#) e-mails to the press. He responded to none of them.

Six weeks later, in May, Mamdani voted to approve the FY2025-2026 state budget – an act for which, in and of itself, based on my March e-mails to him, he must be indicted and will be convicted of a succession of penal law violations, a selection of which I first alerted him to in 2020, by the fully-documented grand jury/public corruption complaint to the Queens D.A. that I furnished him twice.

[The New York Times](#) and a huge swathe of other NY press had this story before Mamdani's June 24th Democratic primary win, but reported NOTHING – and they have reported NOTHING about it since. None have asked Mamdani what, if anything, he denies or disputes about the e-mails – because, as is obvious from them, he cannot respond without conceding their truth – with the scandal bringing him down, and, also, the other mayoral contenders: Cuomo, as former governor, Adams, as a former NYS senator, each of whom also would have to be indicted and will be convicted, if not, additionally, Sliwa, former chair of the NYS Reform Party.

Illustrative of what the press has been doing, instead, are my three most recent e-mails to [The Times](#) about its journalism, on [July 11th](#), [July 13th](#), and [August 9th](#), without response from it.

I am available to answer your questions and assist you on this explosive story, upending not only the NYC mayoral race, but the races for NYC public advocate, Manhattan borough president, Manhattan D.A., and Brooklyn D.A. – *and that's for starters*.
