Complainant has filed a petition for review of Chief Judge Torruella's order dismissing complainant's complaint of judicial misconduct filed under 28 U.S.C. § 372(c) against a circuit judge.

We deny the petition for review for the reasons stated by Chief Judge Torruella. The complaint charged that the named judge was part of a conspiracy with judges of another circuit, aimed at causing harm to complainant. As Chief Judge Torruella pointed out, the complaint contained no factual support whatsoever for this charge.

In any event, the complaint is now moot because the named judge is no longer a federal judge subject to § 372(c).

The petition for review is denied.
