Dear Ms. Sassower,

Thank you for the email update. Again, I will address your questions and issues in the order they appear.

1. I have reviewed the three added pages, and they appear to be in order. Thank you for adding them. (Note: I am unable to view volume 1 of the record on your website. You may wish to check the link. Volumes 2 and 3 are viewable.)
2. I agree with your proposal to put an "X" on page 581.
3. We are agreed on excluding defendants' affidavits of service. Defendants' Answer may therefore stay where you have placed it.
4. You may include my name and phone number on the cover as proposed.
5. Even after viewing your revised description, I still think the "free-standing evidence" consists of legislative history materials (original and revised bills and resolutions). Nevertheless, in light of Third Department Rule 800.5(a)(6) and to move the process along, I withdraw my request that the "free-standing exhibits" be omitted from the Table of Contents.

Today or tomorrow during business hours, please email me a stipulation pursuant to CPLR 5532. The stipulation should be revised as requested in my email of Monday, June 18 at 6:28 p.m. (copy attached for convenience). I will then execute and return the revised stipulation promptly.
