I will make distribution through other channels of the attached July 8, 2016 letter – now further revised for clarity and to reinforce that what is at issue is NOTICE to the counties to repudiate and challenge the state-imposed D.A. salary increases based on rock-solid, *prima facie* evidence – as to which Dutchess D.A. Grady and yourself, as Dutchess County Attorney, are duty-bound, in the first instance, to make findings of fact and conclusions of law so that Dutchess county government can safeguard its taxdollars and secure accountability from its district attorney.
