Dear Ben,

As discussed, *a propos* of your today's story, below is the July 12th e-mail I sent to Livingston County Attorney Morris, with a copy to Livingston District Attorney McCaffrey. Has it been distributed to "ALL Livingston County's legislators, executive officers & the treasurer/comptroller", as I requested?

Where are their findings of fact and conclusions of law with respect to the EVIDENCE, particularized by the July 8th letter, that the Commission reports on which the HUGE district attorney salary increases since 2012 rest are statutorily-violative, fraudulent -- and unconstitutional? D.A. McCaffrey has known of this EVIDENCE since April 12th – or did he not receive the succession of e-mails that I have sent him on the subject, beginning with that first one, which I have attached.

By the way, I do not believe I have received any response, as yet, from Livingston County to my July 14th FOIL request for info on D.A. McCaffrey's salary AND non-salary benefits, etc. It is attached, along with the e-mail that transmitted it to County Attorney Morris. Do be sure to find out the dollar amount of the package of non-salary benefits that D.A. McCaffrey receives on top of his inflated salary. The figure that I got from Washington County was almost \$50,000 additional, these being for health, dental, taxes, retirement.

I am available to answer questions, including under oath. Will D.A. McCaffrey – and Livingston County's other public officers do likewise?

Subject: Notice to Livingston Co. Government: Your duty to repudiate & challenge the state-imposed D.A. salary increases based on your own D.A. McCaffrey's findings of facts and conclusions of law

Following up our phone conversation moments ago, for which I thank you, attached is the Center for Judicial Accountability's July 8, 2016 letter pertaining to the district attorney salary increases. To assist Livingston County in taking protective steps, I am directly sending this e-mail to Livingston County District Attorney McCaffrey so as to further reinforce his duty to promptly provide you and Livingston County's other public officers with his findings of fact and conclusions of law with respect to the citizen-taxpayer action, *Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. v. Cuomo, et al.* (Albany Co. #1788-2014). Does he deny or dispute its rock-solid evidentiary showing that the judicial salary increases, on which his own district attorney salary increases rest, are statutorily-violative, fraudulent -- & unconstitutional? How about our June 21, 2016 corruption complaint based thereon, filed with Albany County District Attorney Soares? Does he deny or dispute its sufficiency for founding criminal indictments for violations of the penal law – and convictions?
