Dear Mr. Jerry,

Kindly clarify your January 11, 2017 letter, which states "our records are not coded or maintained by the particulars of your request, and thus we cannot identify records response to your request".

My FOIL request, in the first instance, was for the Attorney General's "register of all actions and proceedings prosecuted or defended by him, and of all proceedings in relation thereto", as required by Executive Law 65 – <u>irrespective</u> of whether it separately codes/lists actions and proceedings pursuant to: (1) State Finance Law Article 7-A (citizen-taxpayer actions); (2) State Finance Law Article 13 (New York false claims act); and (3) Executive Law 63-c (action by the people for illegal receipt or disposition of public funds or other property).

Does the Attorney General have the required "register" that I may inspect?
