Your correspondence dated February 22, 2018, headed "RECORDS REQUEST/FOIL: June 8, 2016 public forum on Senate Bill #24-b/Assembly Bill #1131-b, establishing a commission on prosecutorial conduct, sponsored by Senator John DeFrancisco & Assemblyman N. Nick Perry, ETC." was received on that date.

You have requested the following:

- 1. The transcript of the June 8, 2016 public forum. The Assembly maintains no responsive records to this request.
- Written statements and documentary evidence received pertaining to the June 8, 2016 public forum, forming the record thereof. The Assembly maintains no responsive records to this request.
- 3. Any report by any legislator present at the June 8, 2016 public forum or by any legislative committee pertaining to the June 8, 2016 public forum, and, in particular, any report containing findings of fact and conclusions of law with respect to the documentary evidence received. The only responsive document found pursuant to this request is the 2016 Annual Report by the Committee on Judiciary, available online at: http://nyassembly.gov/comm/Judiciary/2016Annual/index.pdf.
- 4. Records or any subsequent legislative public forum or legislative hearing on bills to establish a commission on prosecutorial conduct, including #S.2412, introduced in the Senate on January 13, 2017, and #A.5285, introduced in the Assembly on February 7, 2017. The Assembly maintains no responsive records to this request.
- 5. Memoranda or other records establishing what changes were made by the "amendings" of #S.2412, which, on January 12, 2018, became #S.2412-d – and the Senators who voted on each "amending". The Assembly only responds to requests for documents maintained by the Assembly. Therefore, this request is denied.
- 6. Memoranda or other records establishing what changes were made by the "amendings" of # A.5285, which, on January 16, 2018, became #A.5285-c and the

Assembly members voting on each "amending." The only available records establishing what changes were made by the amendings of A.5285 are the different versions of the bill, which can be accessed online at: http://public.leginfo.state.ny.us/navigate.cgi?NVMUO:.
