

**May 29, 2020 FOIL request – Senate Bill #S.3722 (2017-2018):**

On January 26, 2017, Senators Richard Funke and Joseph Griffo, with other co-sponsoring Senators, introduced Senate Bill/Concurrent Resolution #S.3722, “proposing an amendment to article 7 of the constitution, relating to content of article VII bills”.

According to the Senate’s webpage for the bill, <https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2017/S3722>, it was referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee, which, on February 1, 2017, requested an opinion from the Attorney General. On February 17, 2017, the opinion was referred to the Judiciary Committee. The next year, on January 3, 2018, the same bill was referred to the Judiciary Committee, which, on January 12, 2018, again sought an opinion from the Attorney General. On February 15, 2018, the opinion was again referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Pursuant to FOIL, this is to request: (1) a copy of the Senate’s two requests to the Attorney General for an advisory opinion, including the transmitting letters/e-mails; and (2) the Attorney General’s two advisory opinions – and any subsequent correspondence thereon.
