

**May 29, 2020 FOIL request – Assembly Bill #A.9100 (2020)**

On January 17, 2020, Assemblyman Richard Gottfried, Esq., with many co-sponsoring Assembly members, introduced, into the Assembly, Bill #A.9100, “proposing an amendment to article 7 of the constitution, relating to content of article VII bills”. By “CONCURRENT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY” According to the Assembly’s webpage for A-9100:

On February 21, 2020, the opinion was referred to the Assembly Judiciary Committee.

Pursuant to FOIL, this is to request: (1) a copy of the Assembly request to the Attorney General for an advisory opinion, including the transmitting letter/e-mail; (2) the Attorney General’s advisory opinion – and any subsequent correspondence thereon.
