## <u>July 19, 2021 FOIL request - 2021 Senate & Assembly Concurrent Resolutions</u> "proposing that the constitution be amended by adding a new article V-A; in relation to state government integrity"

On January 6, 2021, Senator Krueger, with other Senators, introduced Senate Concurrent Resolution #855, which was committed to the Senate Judiciary Committee.

According to the Senate's webpage for the resolution, <a href="https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2021/S855">https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2021/S855</a>, on January 8, 2021 it was referred to the Attorney General for opinion. There is no indication as whether the Attorney General furnished an opinion – and the committee to which it was referred.

On January 13, 2021, Assemblyman Carroll, with other Assembly members, introduced Assembly Concurrent Resolution #1929, which was referred to the Assembly Committee on Governmental Operations.

According to the Senate's webpage for the resolution, <a href="https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2021/a1929">https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2021/a1929</a>, on January 21, 2021, it was referred to the Attorney General for opinion and, on February 18, 2021, the opinion was referred to the Assembly Judiciary Committee.

Pursuant to FOIL, this is to request: (1) a copy of the two requests to the Attorney General for opinions, including the transmitting letters/e-mails; and (2) the Attorney General's opinions – and any subsequent correspondence thereon.
