Pursuant to Public Officers Law VI ["Freedom of Information"], Senate Rule IV ["Freedom of Information"], and Assembly Rules VIII ["Public Access to Records"], request is made for the 2020 and 2021 annual reports of the Legislative Ethics Commission, required by Legislative Law §80(7)(I), which states:

"The Commission shall -

Prepare an annual report to the governor and legislature summarizing the activities of the commission during the previous year and recommending any changes in the laws governing the conduct of persons subject to the jurisdiction of the commission, or the rules, regulations and procedures governing the commission's conduct. Such report shall include: (i) a listing by assigned number of each complaint and report received from the joint commission on public ethics which alleged a possible violation within its jurisdiction, including the current status of each complaint, and (ii) where a matter has been resolved, the date and nature of the disposition and any sanction imposed, subject to the confidentiality requirements of this section. Such annual report shall not contain any information for which disclosure is not permitted pursuant to subdivision twelve of this section."
