Article III of the Legislative Ethics Commission's <u>January 3, 2022 Bylaws</u> is entitled "Operations" and its ¶6 entitled "Oaths of Office" reads:

"Every Commissioner shall file an Oath of Office, as required by Public Officers Law §10, within thirty days of being appointed to the Commission. Such Oath of Office shall be filed with the office of the Secretary of State and a copy shall be kept on file at the office of the Commission."

Pursuant to Senate Rule XIV ["Freedom of Information"] and Assembly Rules VIII ["Public Access to Records"], request is made for every such "Oath of Office" filed by "Every Commissioner...within thirty days of being appointed to the Commission", including pertaining to their reappointments.
