Your Chief Counsel Cydney Kelly and your Investigator Carolyn Stachura have corrupted their offices – and are the subject of complaints to you that I have embodied in two requests for full Committee reconsideration of their fraudulent <u>February 28, 2024</u> and <u>March 27, 2024</u> letters informing me of the dismissals of two separate, yet related, fully-documented complaints against Attorney Louis Dingeldey and Attorney Eugene Fahey, each of a far-reaching and serious nature, involving public corruption. According to the letters, there was "insufficient evidence" and "no evidence", following implied investigation.
