This office has received your Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) requests and respond to each as follows, in the order enumerated in your request letter.

(1) FOIL requires this office to disclose reasonably described records that are in our possession and not exempt from disclosure. This request does not reasonably describe any record in this office's possession. To the extent that the request describes records in a manner that admits of our identifying them, we are in possession of no records that fit the description provided. Request denied (*see* Public Officers Law § 89 [3]).

(2) FOIL requires this office to disclose reasonably described records that are in our possession and not exempt from disclosure. This request does not reasonably describe any record in this office's possession. To the extent that the request describes records in a manner that admits of our identifying them, any record of a matter resolved in favor of an accused is statutorily exempt from disclosure and we have no such records in any event. Request denied (*see* CPL 160.50; Public Officers Law §§ 87 [2] [a]; 89 [3]).

(3) FOIL requires this office to disclose reasonably described records that are in our possession and not exempt from disclosure. This request does not reasonably describe any record in this office's possession. To the extent that the request describes records in a manner that admits of our identifying them, we have no such records. To the extent that this request refers to records of a matter resolved in favor of an accused, such is statutorily exempt from disclosure. Request denied (*see* CPL 160.50; Public Officers Law §§ 87 [2] [a]; 89 [3]).


