Dear Matt:

Hi. Just to remind you of the press release I gave you on Saturday night after your show on FOX – which you stuffed into your pocket. Please note that the release leads off with the VERY quote from Henry Hyde that you played during your show: namely, that he's ready to lose his office rather than sell out on his commitment to equal justice under law.

In a nutshell, the two major stories presented by the press release are:

(1) that the House Judiciary Committee ignores, *without* investigation, referral, or even acknowledgment, the HUNDREDS of judicial impeachment complaints it receives from ordinary citizens – although these citizens are no less entitled to their "day in court" than Paula Jones – and their complaints assert that they were deprived of that "day" by the misconduct of federal judges; and

(2) that among these HUNDREDS of judicial impeachment complaints is one against Chief Justice Rehnquist, dated November 6, 1998, setting forth conduct which is impeachable "under the most stringent definition of impeachable offenses".

Although you declined the supporting documentation, which I identified as I held it out to you: our FIVE-YEAR correspondence with the House Judiciary Committee (on the subject of its handling of the HUNDREDS of impeachment complaints it receives) and the impeachment complaint against the Chief Justice, you did so with the kind words, "you're an advocate, I like that".

I was heartened by that comment – much as I was, at the start of our conversation, by your response when I asked whether you truly meant your televised statement that you were "going to report every story that needs to be told".

Now, please tell me what I must do for these extremely relevant, important, and, indeed DYNAMITE, stories to be told – BY YOU.
