Attached is the Center for Judicial Accountability's 11-page letter to the Senate leadership, requesting, *inter alia*, postponement of tomorrow's Senate confirmation proceedings on the nomination of Senate Judiciary Committee Chairman James Lack to the Court of Claims.

The letter also presents serious and substantial opposition to Chairman Lack's confirmation. This, based on his official misconduct as head of the Senate Judiciary Committee, overseeing judicial confirmations, wherein he has demonstrated "his flagrant disregard for the most fundamental rules of procedure, standards of evidence, due process, honesty, and decency -- the very qualities essential to being a judge."
